

All Star Pro Golf chose to reserve commentary on the issue of tariffs. With the situation changing every day, and a lot of speculation on possible disruptions to the supply chain, it seemed premature to announce our response to the tariffs until we had a firm handle on how our pricing structure could, or would, be affected.

We can remain silent no longer. Many of our suppliers have either raised our costs or have imposed a straight, across-the-board tariff on the raw goods we purchase from them. As a small business, we have tried to absorb what we could afford to absorb and still survive. It has simply become too much to bear.

Therefore, effective today, May 5, 2025, ASPG will:

- Initiate a straight pass through of the tariffs we now have to pay for pencils at the rate of \$1.30 per gross, regardless of style or color. This tariff will apply to any order that hasn't already shipped and WILL apply to pre-booked pencil orders as well.
- Raise our wholesale prices on almost all of the Pride retail, green grass and custom products we distribute. Domestic suppliers are feeling the pinch too as there is usually a foreign component to everything we make in this country.
- Do its best to find alternative sources for products that are produced in certain countries so that we are not forced to raise our prices even higher. We're also doing this because we anticipate a growing backlog of shipments coming out of China for many months to come. We're already seeing four months delays on some back-ordered items.

Our commitment to you is to remain as transparent as possible as we navigate these supply chain challenges. We also promise to shoot straight with you when items are out-of-stock, and remain as consultative as ever as we work to find substitutions and alternatively-sourced products, when necessary.

And here's one bit of good news in all of this uncertainty: Our warehouse is fully-stocked with the same bulk and packaged hardwood tees you've enjoyed for over two decades.
